North East Special Infrastructure Development Scheme (NESIDS)

The Ministry of DoNER had launched the North East Special Infrastructure Development Scheme (NESIDS) as a new Central Scheme to be fully funded by the Government of India during 2017-18 to fill up gaps of infrastructure relating to water supply, power, connectivity especially for promotion of tourism. The other sectors which can be funded under this programme are the creation of infrastructure in social sector, primarily in primary & secondary education and health.

Projects sanctioned under NESIDS: The Ministry of DoNER has sanctioned 12 (twelve) no. of projects at a total cost of ₹370.11 crore and the Ministry has released ₹ 161.85 crore out of which 1 (one) no. of project had been completed under **NESIDS** support of an amount of ₹ 34.74 crore.

The 11 (eleven) no. of ongoing projects sanctioned by the Ministry of DoNER at a total cost of ₹ 335.38 crore and the Ministry of DoNER has released ₹ 127.11 crore of which the State Government has utilized ₹ 113.74 crore as detailed below:
