This is the tenth (10) publication in the series, the data present in this issue have been collected from various Government Departments, Government undertakings and also from the published/documents of recognized institutions.

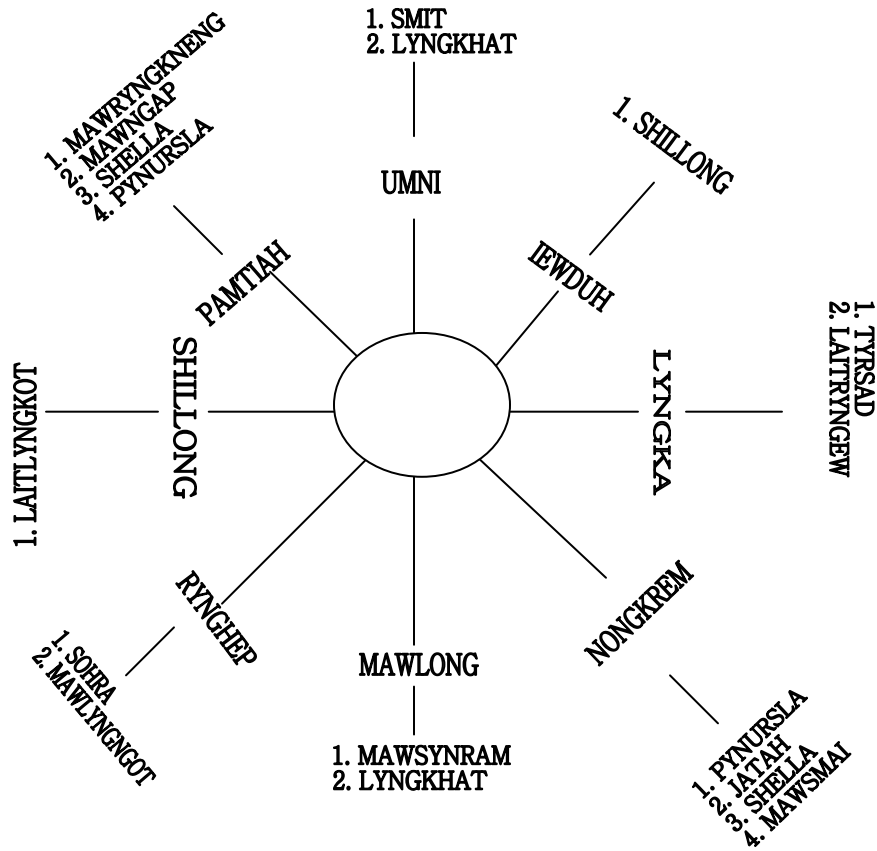

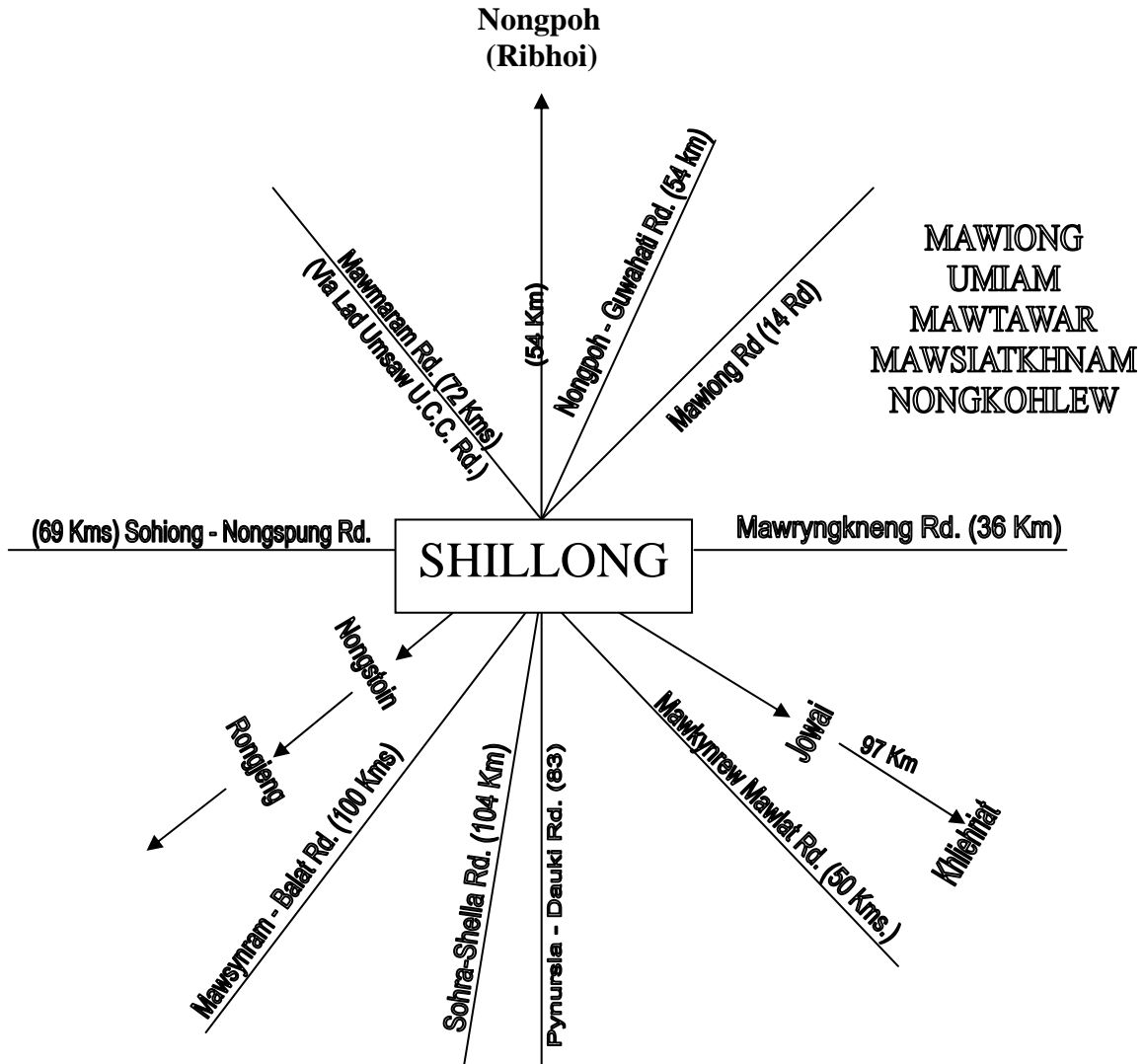
**CLOCK-WISE ROTATION OF AN EIGHT DAYS-A-WEEK SYSTEM KNOWN AS “IEW”**
